

Best Plants for Low Light

★ Most Forgiving & Easy

Snake Plant (*Sansevieria*)

Almost indestructible! Tolerates very low light and infrequent watering.

ZZ Plant (*Zamioculcas zamiifolia*)

Glossy leaves, slow-growing, and super tolerant of low light and occasional neglect.

Pothos (*Epipremnum aureum*)

Great trailing plant for shelves — does well with low light (just watch for very pale leaves).

Philodendron (Heartleaf)

Soft, heart-shaped leaves and easy care — great for beginners.

Classic & Stylish

Peace Lily (*Spathiphyllum*)

Loves shade and even blooms in lower light — just keep soil moist.

Cast Iron Plant (*Aspidistra elatior*)

As the name suggests, tough as nails — perfect for dark corners.

Chinese Evergreen (*Aglaonema*)

Gorgeous patterned foliage and adaptable to lower light levels.

Spider Plant (*Chlorophytum comosum*)

Great for hanging baskets — tolerates low light (though grows faster with a bit more).

Quick Care Tips for Low-Light Plants

✨ Water less often — soil dries slower without strong light, so wait until the top inch of soil feels dry.

✨ Rotate your plants every week so all sides get light.

✨ Dust leaves occasionally — clean leaves absorb light better.

✨ Avoid total darkness — even “low light” plants need some indirect light.

North-facing windows or bright shade are ideal.
